

- understand concepts, retain deeper knowledge and improve their academic performance


Lessons and assignments will be kept updated periodically. This will drastically improve time-bound homework completion and conceptual understanding and will provide unique and individualistic experiences for students.

Assessments and Evaluation



The **Connected Classrooms™** platform is available on most devices, computers, laptops, smartphones, or tablets.


Secure Login and Password

Open a web browser and go to www.connectedclassrooms.in



- Cache settings




You can access your account by following the steps below.

Login as Student with Username and Password

You have been provided with a unique 'Username' and 'Password' by your school. Use these to directly access your account. To do so, follow these steps:


- * Open a web-browser and go to www.connectedclassrooms.in


Upon successful login, you will be directed to your personalized **Home Page**. Let us understand the basics of the Home Page and see how to manage your learning process.




List View

The Home Page

You can see many icons on the home page. Let us simplify the different categories and then understand how the things work.



On the top-right you can see your name, followed by three icons namely **Profile**, **Settings** and **Logout**.




Profile shows the details of the user, like name, user name, class, email and contact number.

Settings – By clicking on this icon you will be able to change your password. *It is suggested that you should change your password after every 2-3 months.*


Logout – Logout button as the name suggests, closes the user current session. *It is recommended to always logout once the work is done.*

You can also see the **school logo** and **name** followed with **email address** and **phone number** in the second row.




Below, you can see a button, **Write New Message** which leads to New Message page. This page can be used to convey any message directly to the school admin.

To send a message to the school, write subject of your message in the **subject box**, write **complete message** in the box given below and click on **Send Message**. Your message will be sent to school admin.



The Dashboard

Every time you login, by default you will reach on this page. You will see four sections **Posts**, **Homework**, **Assessments** and **Re-Tests** on your dashboard.



The ClassBoard and Subject Tabs


Class Board – Class board is a tab where you will get all the posts made by your class teacher related to various class activities.

Subject Tabs – You will get a separate tab for each of your subject which you study in your class. All the posts made by your subject teachers can be seen by clicking on the respective subject tab.



Red circle notification – This notifies you the number of unread posts in that subject.

Once you click on a subject tab, you get a search-box that allows you to **filter by chapter** and **filter by** (*recent post, popular post and homework*) options to find a specific post related to that subject.

Change Password




Forgot Password
